GENERAL DIRECTION TO THE APPLICANTS FOR ONLINE APPLICATION

1. Applicants should register in the online admission portal <http://ug.hgcadmission.org>. They should remember their user id, password, registered mobile number and email id. All these parameters would be required if the applicant is selected for admission after generation of merit list.
2. Applicants are advised to make choice of the subjects wisely during application procedure. Random requests for change of subject after initiation of admission procedure may not be entertained by the college authority.
3. Applicants are advised to avoid any typographical error. Any wrong information furnished in the application as a result of typing error may lead to cancellation of the application. The college authority has the right to cancel any application if it is proved to be erroneous during verification. Application not accompanied by proper supporting documents will also be cancelled.
4. Each applicant is to pay a non-refundable application fee of amount of Rupees fifty only (Rs 50/-) either through payment gateway or opting for offline payment.
5. Applicants paying through bank challan can deposit their application fees in any branch of ICICI bank.
6. Applicants belonging to reserved categories (SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, PWD etc.) and enlisted in the provisional merit list must produce their caste/ disability certificates at the time of counselling failing which they will not be eligible to the reservation.
7. Documents required at the time of counselling:
 - a) Print out of application form
 - b) Madhyamik/equivalent examination admit card in original along with a self attested photocopy of the same.
 - c) Higher secondary/equivalent examination mark sheet in original along with a self attested photocopy of the same.
 - d) Caste certificate in original along with a self attested photocopy of the same, if applicable.
 - e) Physical disability certificate in original along with a self attested photocopy of the same, if applicable.
8. Candidates who have passed their higher secondary before 2017 must submit an undertaking stating that he/she has not taken any admission in any other college or not registered to any university. If the candidate is registered to any other University, standard norms of the Vidyasagar University in addition to eligibility criteria of the college will apply for new admission.



Anti-Ragging Policy

6. According to the direction of the Supreme Court if any instance of ragging is brought to the notice of the administration or the faculty, it is legally binding on us to report the matter to the local police.
7. Seniors are given directives so that any interaction on their part, with the freshers might remain the friendly, welcoming and non-aggressive.

Eligibility Criteria

Honours degree course:

Qualifying Higher Secondary or equivalent examination 2017 with minimum 45% marks in aggregate to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies) or 50% marks in subject or related subject.

General degree course:

Pass marks in at least five subjects in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.

Other Important Information

- i. Any candidate seeking admission to a course in laboratory based subjects must have obtained pass marks in those subjects / relevant subjects at the Higher Secondary level.
- ii. In addition to the above any candidate seeking admission to Honours course in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Economics must have passed in Mathematics in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.
- iii. Any candidate seeking admission to Honours courses in Anthropology, Economics, Education, Sociology or Statistics and not having these subjects at H.S. or equivalent level, must have any one of the following relevant subjects in Higher Secondary or equivalent course:

- iv. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in 2015 and 2016 may also apply.
- v. Candidates who have passed +2 level examinations from West Bengal Council of Vocational Education and Training Board or Open School are eligible to apply for only B.A/B.Sc. general courses and Tourism and Travel Management.
- vi. The candidates who will opt for Physical Education as a general subject will have to pass a qualifying examination.



N.B.: Admission into any course under this College is not complete unless and until a candidate is registered under the Vidyasagar University through this College. Any suppression of facts, false statements, if revealed in future will lead to the cancelation of admission.

Merit Point Calculation:

- a) Admission will be done on merit basis and merit point for admission in Honours courses is to be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies at Higher Secondary/equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or related subject in which the admission in Honours course is sought.
- b) The merit points for admission to General courses are to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies of H.S. / equivalent examination.
- c) Candidates who desire to take admission in Tourism and Travel Management (TTM), a self-financed course are advised to visit the page on self financed courses in the college website for fee structure and other details.

Note: If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to the one who has scored higher marks in the subject, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same marks in the subject; preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in 1st Language.
